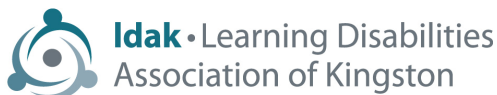


Would your child like to learn how to make and keep friends?

...an after-school social skills program for 9–11 year olds, run by the Learning Disabilities Association of Kingston, in collaboration with Lord Strathcona Public School.

About the program...

Children will be placed in small groups and assigned a social skills coach (1:4). They will learn essential skills for getting along with others through

- social stories;
- role play; and
- indoor and outdoor games.

Children will be photographed while re-enacting each week's social skill. The photographs will be used to create social skills picture books that can be taken home for review.

Fee...

\$30 per child. Subsidies can be arranged for families who require them.

May 18 – June 22, 2010

The program will run once a week on Tuesdays from 3:30 p.m. until 5:00 p.m., for a total of six weeks.
